A blizzard warning has been issued from Monday to Wednesday

morning for the greater Lake Tahoe area. It is only the eighth blizzard warning issued for the area since 2005. The last time one was issued was in January of 2021. A blizzard is defined by large amounts of blowing snow, winds over 35 mph and visibility of less than a quarter mile, according to the National Weather Service. In the Tahoe area, four to six feet of snow are forecast between Monday morning and Wednesday morning at elevations above 7,000 feet. Near-zero visibility is forecast from Monday through Wednesday morning.

Due to the freezing temperatures and the huge amount of snow we are receiving sales have been slow. However the good news is that the Reno/Tahoe area needs this precipitation for the coming summer. If you would like more information, please do
